### New Features

**ID #2233 Global metadata search**

Added functionality so that the user can search a single value across all metadata fields.

**ID #2237 Added Scroll bar to choice pull down menus**

Added scroll bar to choice pull down menus to make navigation easier than current system-supplied up/down arrows.

**ID #2238 Auto media creation to vault wizard**

Added auto media creation options to the Device page in Vault Wizard for hard disk vault configuration.

**ID #2244 Picture support for assets**

Added new viewer for picture assets; has no media control buttons on it since they don't apply to non-video assets. Added search criteria for asset type: Video, Picture, Any.

**ID #2246 Only process directories which meet time criteria for time specs**

Previously, directories were always processed as long as "Process directories..." is checked in the criteria. Now directories will only be processed if they meet the time specs when running incrementals, differentials, levels, or date-based.

**ID #2264 Use clipname when exporting ALE file instead of filename**

When exporting an Avid ALE file and writing the file, the clipname will be retrieved from the metadata and used instead of the filename.

**ID #2283 Sort search results by metadata field**

Added a new search results sorting method which allows users to select a metadata field to sort the search results on: either ascending or descending.

**ID #2299 Export logging option on the export page**

The export page now has the option to export logging data. All of the logging associated with each video being exported will be written to a file in XML format.

**ID #2311 Added Scroll bar on metadata viewer to see entire line of metadata**

In the metadata viewer, if a field and value are too long to be displayed, a scroll bar will appear and allow the user to scroll and view all of the text.

**ID #2313 Adobe Premiere export choice**

Added a choice to the export page to generate an XML file that can be imported by Adobe Premiere.

**ID #2317 Default operator is "AND" for content searches**

Previously, the default search term separator/operator was "OR" meaning a search would return all hits that match any of the terms. Now the default is "AND" which means the content searches will perform more like Google where each term addition results in a more precise hit.



### **ID #2369    Telestream Vantage and FlipFactory integration for LRP creation**

Can now choose to use Vantage or FlipFactory to create the Low Res Proxy videos that will be ingested with the rest of the data.

### **ID #2371    Option to ignore deleted files in search**

Previously, files marked for deletion were included in the search results. Now there is an option in the Advanced menu to either include or not include deleted files in the search results.

### **ID #2372    Added media name to file tips**

The media name will appear in the hover-over file tips.

### **ID #2372    Export a search results list**

Option was added in the File menu to save the selected search results or to save all the search results.

### **ID # 2373    “Test Run” to show file and media status before running a job**

Doing a “Test Run” will do a “pre-flight” retrieval of the selected files and show media information for all needed media. This media information will show media name and current online/offline status.

### **ID #2375    Allow user to enable/disable the resize handle**

In the user preferences window, user can now enable and disable the resize handle in the bottom right hand corner.

### **ID #2376    Stacking panels for search criteria and export queue**

The search criteria and export queue are now stacking panels. This allows the user to minimize and maximize each panel which will also change the size of the search results panel.

### **ID #2377    Allow the user to choose the search results layout**

User can choose a display option for the search results: thumbnails, list, or details. This will change how the files are displayed in the search results panel and how much information is displayed.

### **ID #2377    Right-click menu on assets**

Right-clicking on an asset in the search results pane will now display a menu that allows the user to: show related files, show/edit metadata, change thumbnail, change low res, add file to group, remove from search results list, select all, unselect all, send to export queue, and play.

### **ID #2380    Added logging information to Avid ALE export**

Any logging information associated with a video will be written to the ALE file when performing an Avid ALE export.

### **ID #2388    Added logging information to Final Cut XML export**

Any logging information associated with a video will be written to the XML file when performing a Final Cut XML export.

### **ID #2390    KeyReg key to disable showing delete files in search results**

A new KeyReg key will disable allowing the user to include delete files in their search results.

### **ID #2395    User preferences options were regrouped for better organization**

The user preferences options were rearranged and regrouped for better organization.

### **ID #2399    Added logging information to Adobe Premiere XML export**

Any logging information associated with a video will be written to the XML file when performing an Adobe Premiere XML export.



**ID #2401 Added version to Final Cut ALE and Premiere XML output**

A unique version string will be generated and placed in the XML and ALE files. The version will change whenever the output format changes.

**ID #2403 Removed sort button and added a status line**

Removed the sort button from the search results section, results can still be sorted via the view menu. The status line at the bottom of the window now displays "Found", "Sorted by", and "Export".

**ID #2404 Added version to export queue XDL file**

A version element will be included in the XDL file that is created when the export queue entries are saved to a file.

**ID #2424 Ability to export metadata in XML format**

New functionality to export metadata in XML format without any file retrievals.

**ID #2437 New timestamp value added**

On the criteria panel of Target & Process, the options for "Perform job based on the last time files were" have changed depending on the platform.

**ID #2438 New token "Date" added to metadata config file**

A new metadata token has been added. The type is "Date". The value is entered in the format yyyy/mm/dd and there is a calendar browse button next to the field.

**ID #2431 Added new functionality for an automatic re-grouping of files**

Files can be automatically re-grouped based on directory structure and naming. It will do a smart re-group of files to associate video with low res proxy, thumbnail, logging, and speech/text files.

**ID #2494 Multiline string metadata field**

When entering a string metadata field, the data field may be multiline and the text will wrap.
